



About Natac

Natac (NAT) it is an industrial group founded in 2010, dedicated to the manufacture and commercialization of healthy ingredients of natural origin, primarily **plant extracts and omega-3 oils**.

Its products are for the nutraceutical, pharmaceutical, food, animal nutrition, and cosmetic sectors. Since November 2023, the company has been listed on BME Growth, where it carried out the second-largest capital increase in the history of this market.




The group operates under a B2B model and has three production plants in Spain, in addition to commercial offices in the United States and Singapore.

Its first factory, located in Palenciana (Córdoba), began operations in 2012 and is dedicated exclusively to olive extracts. Later, in 2021, Natac expanded its production capacity with the opening of a multiproduct plant in Hervás (Cáceres), which is considered one of the most efficient in the world for the manufacture of plant extracts.

This state-of-the-art facility can process up to 3,000 tons of raw material per year, producing both natural ingredients and active plant-based compounds for the pharmaceutical sector, after obtaining **GMP certification**.

The company's third production unit is located in As Somozas (A Coruña) and is **the largest omega-3 factory in Spain**. Operational since September 2024, it is situated on a 28,000 m² site and uses cutting-edge technology to process omega-3 oils derived from fish. Innovative ingredients for the food, nutraceutical, and animal nutrition sectors are developed at this facility.



Innovation and Sustainability in the DNA

Natac combines state-of-the-art technology with a strong commitment to innovation and sustainability. Its comprehensive approach—from the responsible sourcing of raw materials to large-scale production—positions the company as a global benchmark in the manufacture of high-quality natural ingredients for various industries.

Since its founding, the group has participated in and led more than 45 national and international R&D projects, with a leadership position in Europe, evidenced by the most ambitious project to date: **SustainNext**.

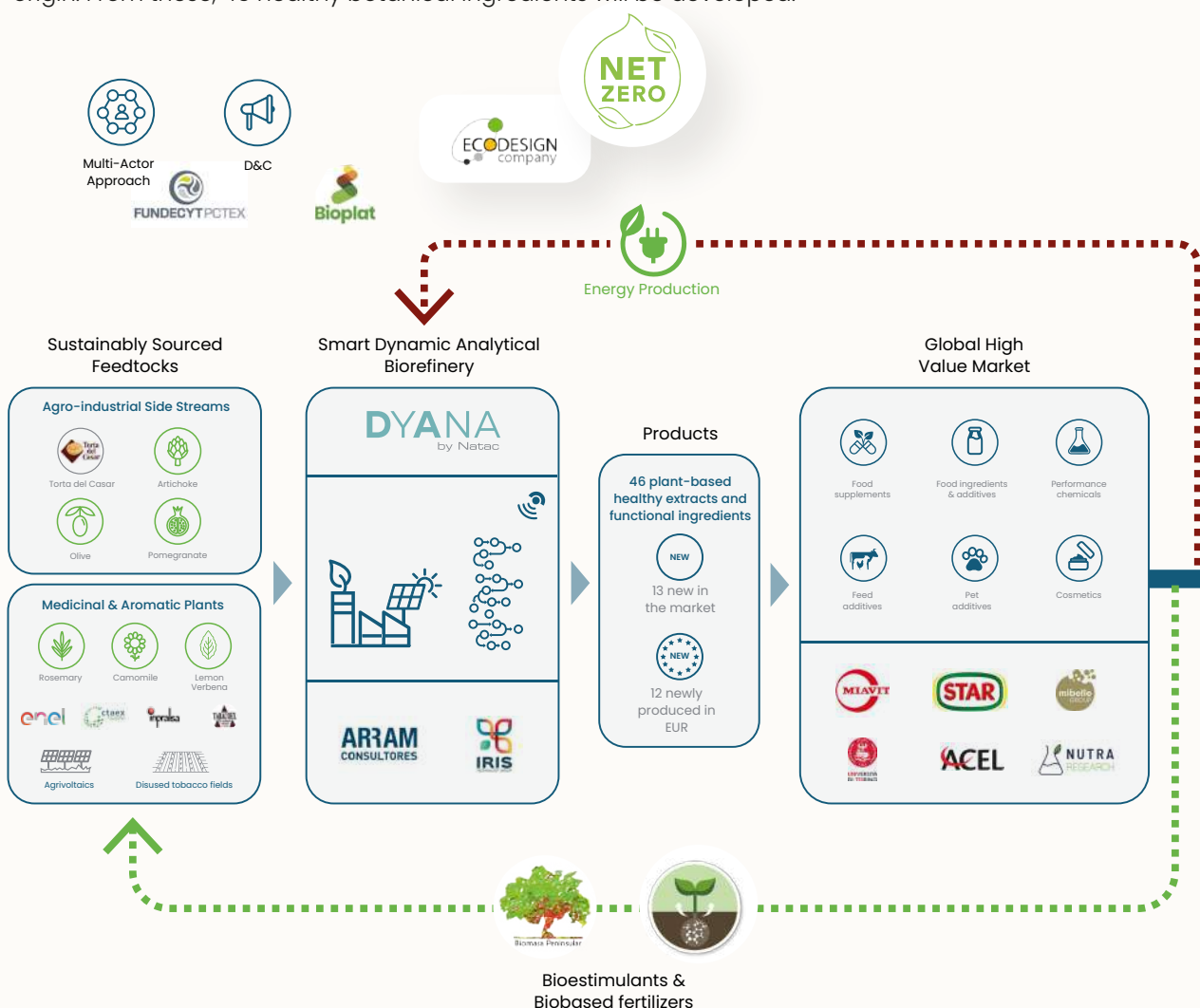


This project belongs to the Flagship category, which promotes the construction of large industrial facilities that are unique in their kind and highly innovative, under a model of economic and environmental sustainability. Its goal is to contribute to the expansion of the circular economy in Europe. SustainNext, with a budget of €22 million, is the first project in this category that the European Union has awarded entirely to Spain since the program's inception in 2014.

Natac leads a consortium of 21 European partners to bring this project to life, which aims to transform the traditional botanical extract industry by implementing a digital, dynamic, versatile, disruptive, and multiproduct biorefinery at an industrial scale, with high processing capacity and following a NetZero Carbon strategy.

The ultimate goal of SustainNext is to transform Natac's current production plant in Hervás into the most modern, digital, innovative, and sustainable plant for plant extracts in the world, positioning both the company and the region at the forefront of the global industry.

The project will be industrially implemented using six European raw materials of sustainable and local origin. From these, 46 healthy botanical ingredients will be developed.
